Midtown Fulton Bank branch to move

Harrisburg developer Powers & Associates is adding to its list of projects at North Third and Reily streets in the city's midtown.

The company on Monday announced a deal to relocate Fulton Bank's midtown branch to 1429 N. Third St. Under the \$1 million project, three structures at 1425-1427-1429 N. Third St. are being rehabilitated into an 8,400-square-foot complex.

The Fulton Bank branch, a block north of its old location, will have a drive-through window and an exterior ATM machine. Powers & Associates will redevelop the site Fulton is vacating at 1401 N. Third St. into a commercial complex.

Powers & Associates is developing several midtown tracts, including the 75,000-square-foot Campus Square retail and office building at Third and Reily streets, which will open next year.
